Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct and Commitment

Please read, initial and sign this document and turn it in. (Please print double sided)

We/I, as parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that God has called me/us as a parent to instruct my/our child in the faith. We/I am/are the one(s) primarily responsible for my/our child's Christian education, but request that Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy further assist me/us in honoring my/our commitments as a parent. We/I also give testimony that we/I am/are a Christian disciple and am/are called to bear witness to God's word in Jesus Christ. We/I agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct & Commitments:

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

We/I agree to try at all times to manifest by daily example the highest Christian virtue serving as a Christian role model (1Timothy 4:12) both in and out of my/our home, but in particular while We/I am/are on school property or attending CMCA events. I/we agree to be a role model in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. We/I acknowledge that this includes, but is not limited to, maintaining a modest appearance, the refraining from such activities as intemperate use of alcohol (being drunk), use of tobacco or other smoking products, use of illicit drugs, use of vulgar and profane language and all forms of violence and hatred, including bullying, trash talk, hazing, profanity, and vandalism.

We/I agree that God has a plan for me and my child, and that sexuality is a gift from God as clearly defined in scripture. (Romans 12:1-2; I Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; I Thessalonians 4:3-8; I Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 2:19-22; I Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; I John 3:1-3). While on school grounds and while attending CMCA events, or activities, we/I agree to conduct myself according to biblical principles at all times. This means that we/I will refrain from any sexual misconduct, including, but not limited to, premarital sex, extramarital affairs, homosexual activity, sexual harassment, use or viewing of pornographic material or websites, sexual abuse of children, and other forms of sexually deviant behavior. We/I understand that such public behaviors or deviations from Scripture are grounds for my child's expulsion.

We/I also agree that the unique roles of the male and female are clearly defined in Scripture, and that Romans 1:24-32 condemns the homosexual lifestyle (Romans 12:1-2; 1 Cor. 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8; 1 Timothy 4:12; 2 Timothy 2:19-22; 1 Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; 1 John 3:1-3). Accordingly, We/I agree that we/I will not engage in any homosexual behavior, or publically support homosexuality.

We/I agree to try at all times to understand, appreciate, love, and serve my fellow brothers and sisters in the community, my/our friends, and family members, and will to the best of my/our ability encourage my/our own and their own spiritual, intellectual, physical, and emotional development, through regular prayer, scripture study and memorization, fellowship, and discernment of God's gifts.

We/I will faithfully support CMCA through our prayers and positive attitude, and in keeping with Matthew 18:15, we/I are committed to share any complaints and negative comments only with the people involved, and agree that social media and the internet is not an appropriate place to address concerns or complaints about the staff, students, or parents. Unresolved issues will be taken care of using the school's chain of command, which is the staff, and then superintendent. I/we agree to follow the biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 for conflict resolution. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing biblical principles.

We/I understand that the standard of Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy does not tolerate profanity, obscenity in word or action, dishonor to the Word of God, disrespect to the personnel of the school, or continued disobedience to the established policies of the school.

We/I believe that discipline is necessary for the benefit of each student as well as for CMCA, and we/I give permission to the staff and activity coordinators to enforce school regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles. We/I commit to pay for any damages to the school/event sites including broken windows, graffiti, and abuse of other personal property caused or created by my child. We/I further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in the home as needed.

We/I understand that CMCA is a non-accredited school (Independent Study Program).

We/I agree to attend 10 meetings per school year and to turn in paperwork when it is due.

Our/my children recognize our /my God-given authority in our home.

We/I realize educating our children through CMCA is our responsibility, we will not place blame on CMCA for failing in that purpose.

We/I agree to keep HSLDA membership current as part of our mandatory requirement for enrollment.

We/I agree to faithfully attend and financially support a local church whose fundamental beliefs are in agreement with the Statement of Faith (Hebrews 10:25.) and have returned a Pastor's Reference.

We/I understand that achievement testing is mandatory for 6th –11th grade students.

We/I understand that if we sign up for some events, but do not attend we will be required to pay a "no show fee".

We/I understand it is our responsibility to know the information in the CMCA Handbook and follow the policies therein.

We/I understand that our high school students must abide by the Connect Guidelines found in the CMCA Handbook and will share these guidelines with them. We/I will be responsible for my student's actions at high school functions.

We/I understand that if our students take classes/sports at Calvary Murrieta Christian School we will abide by CMCS' policies and procedures located in the CMCS Handbook and will check the Advisements on-line for information and changes for each day. We/I realize this is our responsibility.

If CMCA/CMCS payments or paperwork is not current We/I understand that my student will not be allowed to participate in sports practices or games until payments are made and paperwork is current.

We/I understand and will fulfill my/our financial commitment to pay for services CMCA is providing. I/we also understand that there are absolutely no refunds on registration fees.

We/I have read the foregoing Code of Conduct, Commitment, the Dress Code and fully understand what is expected of me/us. We/I am committed to uphold these standards and am fully committed to my role as a parent and Christian role model at Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy. We/I also understand that agreeing with and adhering to this Code of Conduct is a condition of my/our family's enrollment and that any public or publically known violations or deviations from this Code of Conduct are grounds for my/our family's expulsion. It is understood that the service of Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy is engaged by mutual consent and that either we or the school reserve the right to terminate any or all services at any time by written notification. It is the Parent's responsibility to inform their students so they understand the Dress Code, Code of Conduct and School Policies outlined in the CMCA Handbook.
