

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AND COMMITMENT

I/we, as parent(s)/guardian(s) understand that God has called me/us as a parent to instruct my/our child in the faith. I/we also give testimony that I/we am/are a Christian disciple and am/are called to bear witness to God's word in Jesus Christ. I/we agree to adhere to the following Code of Conduct & Commitments:

PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

1. I/we will accept and act in accordance with the school's Statement of Faith, Philosophy, and Policies, and I am committed to upholding them.
2. I/we agree to try at all times to manifest by daily example the highest Christian virtue serving as a Christian role model (1 Timothy 4:12) both in and out of my/our home, but in particular while I/we am/are on school property or attending school events.
3. I/we agree that learning is not only through receiving and interpreting rational explanations of formal subject material, but even more powerfully through word, deed, example, and shared experience. While on school grounds and while attending CMCA events or activities, I/we agree to be a role model in judgment, dignity, respect, and Christian living. I/we acknowledge that this includes, but is not limited to, the refraining from such activities as intemperate use of alcohol (being drunk), use of tobacco or other smoking products, use of illicit drugs, and the use of vulgar and profane language.
4. I/we agree that God has a plan for me and my child, and that sexuality is a gift from God as clearly defined in Scripture. (Romans 12:1-2; I Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; I Thessalonians 4:3-8; I Timothy 4:12; II Timothy 2:19-22; I Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; I John 3:1-3). While on school grounds and while attending school or church events or activities, I/we agree to conduct myself according to biblical principles at all times. This means that I/we will refrain from any sexual misconduct, including, but not limited to, premarital sex, extramarital affairs, homosexual activity, sexual harassment, use or viewing of pornographic material or websites, sexual abuse of children, and other forms of sexually deviant behavior. I/we understand that such public behaviors or deviations from Scripture are grounds for my child's expulsion.

5. I/we also agree that the unique roles of the male and female are clearly defined in Scripture, and that Romans 1:24-32 condemns the homosexual lifestyle (Romans 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 6:9-20; Ephesians 4:1-11, 5:3-5; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-8; 1 Timothy 4:12; 2 Timothy 2:19-22; 1 Peter 1:15-16, 2:15-17; 1 John 3:1-3). Accordingly, I/we agree that I/we will not engage in any homosexual behavior, or publicly support homosexuality.

6. I/we agree to try at all times to understand, appreciate, love, and serve my fellow brothers and sisters in the community, my/our friends, and family members, and will to the best of my/our ability encourage my/our own and their own spiritual, intellectual, physical, and emotional development, through regular prayer, Scripture study and memorization, fellowship, and discernment of God's gifts.
7. I/we agree to conduct myself on campus and at school-sponsored or school-related events, in a manner worthy of the calling I/we have received. This includes maintaining a modest appearance, engaging in regular prayer, refraining from all forms of violence and hatred, including bullying, trash talk, hazing, profanity, and vandalism.
8. I/we agree to follow the biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 for conflict resolution. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing biblical principles.

PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT

1. I/we will faithfully support the school through our prayers and positive attitude, and in keeping with Matthew 18:15, I/we are committed to share any complaints and negative comments only with the people involved, and agree that social media and the internet is not an appropriate place to address concerns or complaints about staff, students, or parents. Unresolved issues will be taken care of using the school's chain of command, which is the CMCA Staff, then superintendent.
2. I/we understand that the standard of Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy does not tolerate profanity, obscenity in

word or action, dishonoring the Word of God, disrespect to the personnel of the school, or continued disobedience to the established policies of the school.

3. I/We understand that CMCA is a non-accredited school (Independent Study Program).
4. I/We agree to attend 10 meetings per school year and to turn in paperwork when it is due the night of the meeting.
5. I/We understand that I/we may miss one meeting per year for emergencies or illness but there will be fees if more than one is missed, UNLESS you are paid in full or have an ACH and have NO paperwork due or ANYTHING to pick up and have NO Fieldtrip/Activity Sign-ups, then your absence will be excused.
6. I/We understand that I/We are considered absent if we do not put our Family Folder in the "Done Box".
7. I/We understand that the Wednesday after the meeting is only for those who missed the meeting because of an emergency or illness; Field Trip/Activity sign ups if you missed the opportunity at the meeting; and to help families and answer questions.
8. My/Our children recognize my/our God-given authority in our home.
9. I/We realize educating our children through CMCA is our responsibility, we will not place blame on CMCA for failing in that purpose.
10. I/We agree to keep HSLDA membership current as part of our mandatory requirement for enrollment.
11. I/We agree to faithfully attend and financially support a local church whose fundamental beliefs are in agreement with the Statement of Faith (Hebrews 10:25.) and have returned a Pastor's Reference.
12. I/We understand that achievement testing is mandatory for 6th –11th grade students.
13. I/We understand that there are no refunds for Field Trips and Activities.
14. I/We understand that if we sign up for some events, but do not attend we will be required to pay a "no show fee" as noted in the Newsletter per event.
15. I/We understand it is our responsibility to know the information in the CMCA Handbook and follow the policies therein.
16. I/We understand that our high school students must abide by the Connect Guidelines found in the CMCA Handbook and will share these guidelines with them. We/I will be responsible for my student's actions at high school functions.
17. I/We understand that if our students take classes/sports at Calvary Murrieta Christian School we will abide by CMCS' policies and procedures located in the CMCS Handbook and will check the Advisements on-line for information and changes for each day. We/I realize this is our responsibility.
18. If CMCA/CMCS payments or paperwork is not current I/we understand that my student will not be allowed to participate in sports practices or games until payments are made and paperwork is current.
19. I/We understand and will fulfill our/my financial commitment to pay for services CMCA is providing. We/I also understand that there are absolutely no refunds on registration fees.

I/we have read the foregoing Code of Conduct & Commitment, and I/we fully understand what is expected of me/us. I am committed to uphold the standards outlined in this Code of Conduct & Commitment, and I/we am fully committed to my role as a parent/guardian and Christian role model at Calvary Murrieta Christian Academy. I/we also understand that agreeing with and adhering to this Code of Conduct & Commitment is a condition of my/our child's enrollment and that any public or publicly known violations or deviations from this Code of Conduct & Commitment are grounds for my/our child's expulsion.
